

Zinc Borate 98% • CAS 12447-61-9



Suspected of damage to the unborn child. Very toxic to aquatic life.

Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Avoid release to the environment. If exposed or concerned, get medical advice/attention. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local regulations. Zinc borate is an insoluble powder and close attention must be paid to OSHA respirable dust limits, engineering controls and personal protection equipment.

First Aid

If swallowed, call poison control center or physician. Do not induce vomiting unless directed. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes; remove contact lenses. If on unbroken skin, wash skin. If on broken skin, wash with water and contact physician if irritation noted. If inhaled, remove person to fresh air; if irritation persists, seek medical attention.
